Update on Return-to-School

I am writing to provide an update regarding a return to in-person learning. Unfortunately, at this time, we don't have a definitive return date scheduled. The COVID infection case rate is at an all-time high, currently at 69.7 per 100,000 people, as reported on the County of San Diego COVID Dashboard. Our goal had been to return to in-person learning in the hybrid model when the case rate fell below 6.9 cases per 100,000 people. As you can see, we are far from that target.

We just received new information from the San Diego County Office of Education and the County of San Diego:

- K-6 schools in counties in Purple Tier with a case rate of greater than 25: Schools serving students in grades K-6 may not reopen for in-person instruction in counties with adjusted case rate above 25 cases per 100,000 population per day. Schools are not permitted to resume in-person instruction until the adjusted case rate has been less than 25 per 100,000 population per day for at least five consecutive days.
- Schools may not reopen for grades 7-12 if the county is in Purple Tier.

Among other highlights in the new guidance:

- Minimum distance requirements: 6 feet between adults, no less than 4 feet between students in classrooms
- Facial coverings required for all students regardless of age
- Waiver requests will be approved over seven business days (not five, as before)

We have been able to make progress in bringing very small groups of students back to school in a small cohort model, as allowed by guidance from the <u>California Public Health Department</u>. To that end, we have a number of different programs operating at some of our schools:

We have an afternoon Extended Day Program (EDP) offered at Lemon Grove Academy
Elementary, San Miguel Elementary, and Vista La Mesa. Only students currently enrolled in
the EDP are eligible to participate in this partial day (afternoons only) option. Students
attend school virtually online in the morning, and come to campus in the afternoon for
enrichment and homework support.

What's Happening in the Grove?

- We have a partnership with the City of Lemon Grove, where the City operates a Day Camp program (full-day) for students in grades K-6. We are able to underwrite the weekly cost of this program for LGSD students if they qualify for free or reduced lunch. Students enrolled in Day Camp receive their instruction virtual online, while supervised by trained staff. There is a maximum capacity in this program.
- We are also offering small cohorts on several campuses, where we have students on campus who have really struggled with distance learning, typically with internet connection issues, serious lack of participation in online classes, or social-emotional issues. Students still receive their instruction virtually/online from their regular classroom teacher. They are on campus, supervised by other school staff.



Martin Luther King, Jr. Holiday

As a reminder, the Lemon Grove School District Celebrates MLK, Jr. Day on Monday, January 18th. There is no school on this day.

Why do we celebrate Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.'s birthday? Celebrated on the third Monday in January, Martin Luther King Day is a national holiday that honors the United States' most famous civil-rights activist. The Rev. Dr. King's peaceful struggle against racial discrimination came to national attention in 1955, when he led a boycott protesting laws that required blacks and whites to sit in separate sections on buses. He was jailed and physically attacked, and his home was bombed, but in 1956 the Supreme Court declared such laws unconstitutional. In 1963, King delivered his famous "I Have a Dream" speech before a quarter million people during the peaceful March on Washington, D.C. The next year he became the youngest man, at 35, to receive the Nobel Peace Prize. He continued fighting for civil rights and against poverty until an assassin's bullet ended his life on April 4, 1968.
