Sometimes a child's endless stream of questions can be tiresome, but it should be encouraged.

Paul Harris of Harvard University told <u>The Guardian</u> that asking questions is a helpful exercise for a child's development because it means they realize that "there are things they don't know ... that there are invisible worlds of knowledge they have never visited."

When children start school, those from households that encouraged curious questions have an edge over the rest of their classmates because they've had practice taking in information from their parents, This translates to taking in information from their teacher. In other words, they know how to learn better and faster.



School Spotlight Mt. Vernon School

Mount Vernon is a diverse International Baccalaureate (IB), dual immersion (DI) school. We have 366 active learners in grades Pre-K to 6, coming from diverse backgrounds of races, cultures, and languages. This diversity is a source of our vitality as we constantly strive to design and provide a high quality educational experience for each student. We are very unique because there are less than a handful of IB/DI programs in our state. We are currently transitioning from a 50/50 program to a 90/10 program. Our Kindergarten is taught 90% of the day in Spanish, 10% in English, and our First grade is taught 80% in Spanish, 20% in English. At this time, the remainder of the school is taught 50% in Spanish, 50% in English. This is the timetable for our transition:

Year of Transition	Grade	% Spanish/ % English
2021-22	Kindergarten	90/10
2021-22	First Grade	80/20
2022-23	Second Grade	70/30
2023-24	Third Grade	60/40
No change	Fourth Grade	50/50
No change	Fifth Grade	50/50
No change	Sixth Grade	50/50
